- spectator    A person watching a show or a film at a theatre.
- arrow        Arrows are shot with a bow. Here arrows refer to computer keys with arrows.
- storing      Keeping things, for instance, locked up in cupboards.
- implement   To make happen – bring into action.
- proposal     An idea for a certain problem.
- constitution A country's basic law on which it is based.
- amendment   Something which has been added – in this case, to the US Constitution.
- infringe     Something impossible to change cannot be infringed.
- interpret    To find a way of explaining a problem and its solution.
- individual   An individual is a person.

Owning a gun was related to militias and army-related use.

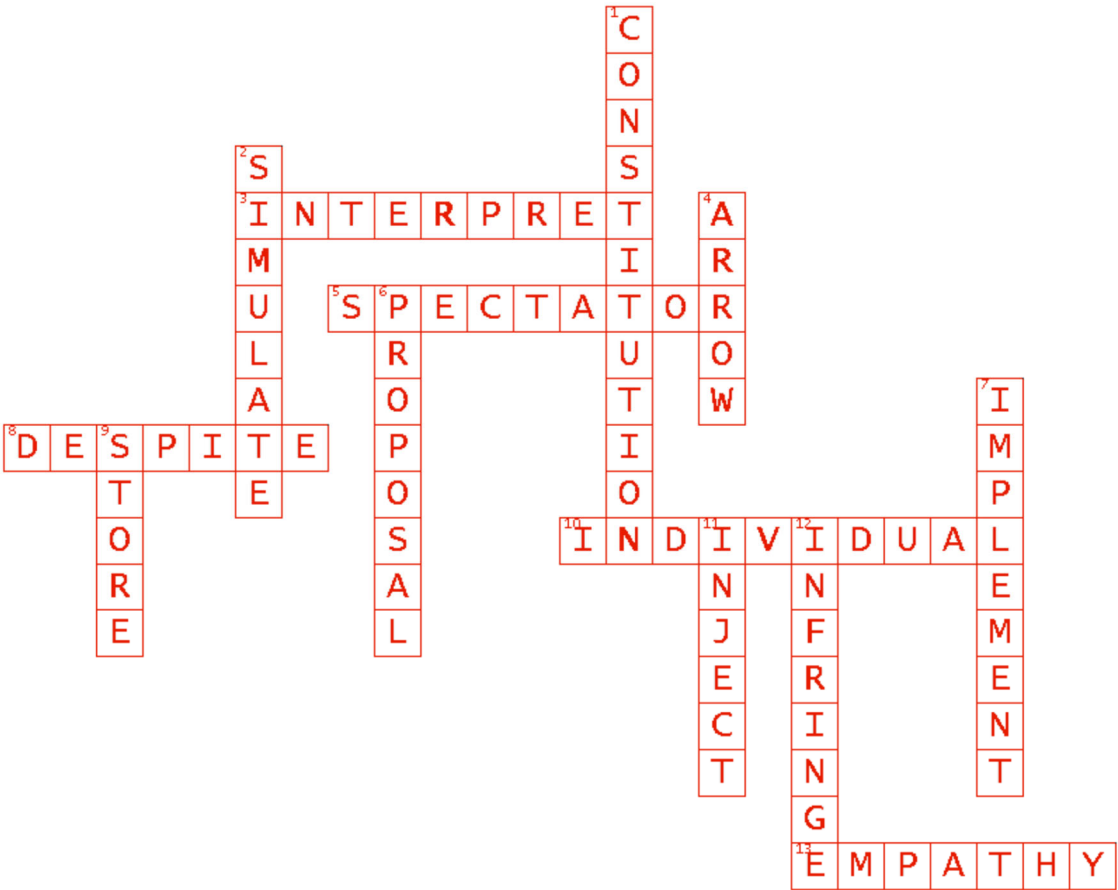
What was the Supreme Court's “landmark decision?”

They claim that weapons do not harm, but people behind them do.

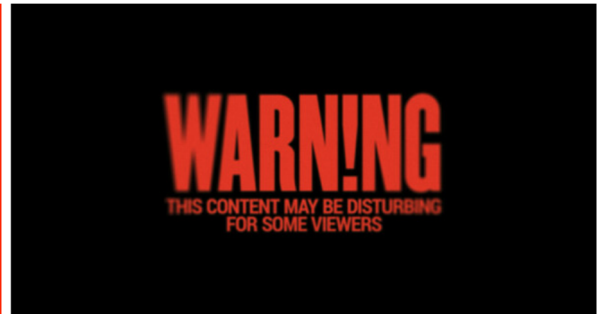
3. Crossword puzzle
